STALL FEES: \$35@, bedding not furnished but available on grounds. Reserve stalls early! Heated indoor arena and make up ring. Grounds fee to show from trailer is \$10 per trailer. Out of state horses must have satisfactory 30 day Health Certificate and 6 month negative Coggins papers.

ENTRY FEES: \$25 per class if received by Show Secretary on or before April 20, 2005. Entry Fees received after April 20, 2005 or day of show will be charged a \$5 post entry fee per class. There is no entry fee for the Pet Costume Class. Classes may be split if entries warrant.

REFRESHMENTS AVAILABLE ON GROUNDS

The Spring Warm-Up is an IASHA point show and shall be conducted in the spirit of USA Equestrian Rules. All attire and mounts in Saddle Seat Academy classes shall conform to UPHA Indiana Academy Club Rules. All riders in Academy classes must be on school horses which currently earn their living in a riding lesson program. Saddle Seat Academy riders are ineligible for non-academy classes except for Costume and Ride A Buck. All Hunt Seat and non-Saddlebred Western classes are open to hunter/western academy riders, who will not be required to show in full attire/appointments for these classes. All riders competing in walk & trot classes are ineligible for any class which requires a canter except Ride A Buck. The Ride A Buck class shall be judged as a "Command Class". In case of disputes, the Show Committee's decision shall be final.
