FEES: Box stall \$35/Tie stall \$25/Grounds fee \$10 to show from trailer. Bedding not furnished but available on grounds. Stabling is limited – reserve stalls early. Indoor arena, indoor & outdoor warm-up areas. All out of state horses must show negative coggins & satisfactory 30-day health papers. Entries close April 7. Post entries accepted. Entry fee \$25 per class. Entries received after April 7, 2007 will be charged a \$5 post entry per class. No entry fee in Pet Costume Class. Management reserves the right to split, cancel or combine any classes for safety or in the best interests of the show. Exhibitors will be notified. In case of any dispute, the decision of the show committee shall be deemed final.

REFRESHMENTS AVAILABLE ON GROUNDS.

TROPHY AND RIBBONS IN EVERY CLASS.

The Spring Warm-up is an IASHA point show and shall be conducted in the spirit of USEF rules. Horse appointments & rider attire in saddle seat academy classes must conform to UPHA Chapter 11 Academy Club rules. All riders in academy classes must be on school horses that currently earn their living in riding lesson programs. Academy riders are ineligible for other classes in show except Pet Costume and Ride-A-Buck. Hunt seat and non-Saddlebred western classes are open to academy western & hunt seat riders who are not required to show in full attire/appointments for these classes. All riders competing in walk & trot classes are ineligible for any class which requires a canter. Horses in AOTS (Amateur, Owner/Trainer Shown) classes cannot have been in professional training for 90 days prior to show or during show. Ride-A-Buck class to be conducted & judged as a WTC command class. Prohibited attire includes leather pants, breeches or jods; shorts; pants, breeches or jods with leather or suede patches. In case of any disputes, decision of the Show Committee shall be deemed final.
